CLASS ATTIRE:

Creative Dance: A pink short sleeve leotard, pink chiffon skirt, pink tights, pink ballet shoes with elastic over instep.

Ballet: Pink seamless tights, pink ballet shoes with elastic over instep, hair pulled back from face and up off neck and secured well. No heavy jewelry or large earrings. No shirts, leg warmers plastic pants, etc.

Levels Beg.1y, 2A, 2B - Light blue short sleeve leotard, light blue chiffon skirt (fingertip length).

Levels Beg.1o & 2C thru 5 - Black leotard in style of choice, black chiffon skirt (fingertip length).

Levels 6, 7, KYB, KDT - Leotard in style and color of choice, chiffon skirt optional.

Young Men: Black tights or shorts, white T-shirt, black ballet shoes or white socks and white shoes.

Jazz, Tap, & Hip Hop: Appropriate style leotard and tights or unitard. Bike shorts or trunks over leotard acceptable.

Girls: no baggy shorts or shirts. Jazz or tap shoes for jazz and tap, and tennis shoes for Hip Hop.

Modern: Tan, black or pink tights with bare feet or lyrical sandals. Leotard of choice; skirts optional.

RECITAL: A costumed recital is held every year in a theatre at the completion of the spring semester. The purpose of the recital is to give students stage experience and an opportunity to demonstrate their achievements. Recital participation is not mandatory, but highly recommended. Costumes are ordered from costume supply companies. The fee for recital is \$55 per student, plus costume cost for each class. Recital fee and costume fees are due in November.

DANCE CLASS: Eighty percent (80%) attendance will be required for consideration of advancement to the next level. Excessive absences may result in student being moved to a lower level.
