Susan Cilie', a graduate of the distinguished High School for the Performing and Visual Arts has taught master classes across the globe and has danced and choreographed her way across the US, Europe, and Asia. Susan has won numerous awards for choreography and entertainment and was also an adjudicator for national dance competitions.

INFORMATION

REGISTRATION: You may create an account online by going to rowlandballard.com or download the App. The Yearly Participation Fee is \$50.00. This fee covers the student's participation in all of the Rowland School dance and gymnastics classes for the full year including summer and is nonrefundable.

TUITION: Tuition is based upon how many hours the student dances. The first hour is \$86.00 per month.

PLACEMENT: Students will be placed in class level as determined by Rowland School staff. New students may be evaluated to determine appropriate level. Missed lessons will not be deducted from the monthly payment. Excessive absences from weekly classes may require a student to be moved to a lower level class, and 80% attendance will be required for consideration of advancement to the next level.

VISITORS: Parents and interested public may observe classes from the observation windows for all studios at any time.

RECITAL: A costumed recital is held every year in a theatre at the completion of the spring semester. The purpose of the recital is to give students stage experience and an opportunity to demonstrate their achievements. Costumes will be ordered from costume supply companies. Recital participation is not mandatory, but highly recommended. Recital participation involves a single \$65.00 recital fee per student (regardless of number of classes student attends), plus purchase of selected costume (approximately \$45.00 to \$120.00) for each class participating in recital.

IMPORTANT NOTE: All students should wear street clothes and street shoes when arriving and departing dance facility. Parents, please instruct students to remain in the reception area until picked up. Teachers cannot stay with students when class is dismissed due to consecutive classes.

CLASS ATTIRE:

BALLET:

GIRLS: Pink ballet shoes with elastic over instep and pink tights.. Hair pinned back and up securely. No heavy jewelry. No shirts, leg warmers, plastic pants, etc. should be worn during class.

CREATIVE DANCE: Pink short sleeve scoop neck leotard, pink chiffon skirt.
BALLET LEVELS 1A, 2A, 2B: Light blue short sleeve leotard, light blue chiffon skirt (fingertip length).
BALLET LEVELS 1B, 3A, 3B, 4A, 4B: Black leotard in style of choice, with black chiffon skirt
BALLET 5, 6, 7, KYB & KYB: Black leotard in style of choice and black skirt

BOYS: Black tights or shorts with white socks, white knit shirt, dance belt, white or black ballet shoes.

ADULTS: Leotard and tights (unitard) of choice, skirts if desired, appropriate dance shoes.

JAZZ, TAP & HIP HOP: Appropriate style unitard, bike-unitard, or leotard with tights; appropriate shoes. Bike shorts or trunks over leotard acceptable. Girls: No baggy shirts/shorts. Please secure hair up off of neck

MODERN: Tan, black, or pink tights with bare feet or lyrical sandals. Leotard of choice. Skirts are optional.
